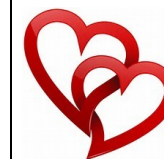


When my daughters were little, we had a ritual every evening to put away their toys. They'd scurry around, gather up their items, and bring them to me where I knelt beside the toy box. As they'd bring each beloved plaything, I'd open the lid, and we'd each say, "Good night, block," or "Good night, Noah's ark," and then they'd place that toy in the box. This ritual was a way of helping them wind down while bringing the evening to a close. Endings matter in a family—even the end of an ordinary day. They deserve a bit of care. Small endings handled well prepare our children for bigger endings, such as friends moving, getting cut from a team, or losing a loved pet or family member.
